Celebration of Learning

Year 5 have been exploring the world of ancient Egypt! We have been making canopic jars to store the organs of the pharaohs. The jars have animal shaped lids linked to the four sons of Horus.

- Imsety had a human head and carried and protected the liver.
- Qebehsenuf had a falcon's head and carried and protected the intestines.
- Hapy had the head of a baboon and carried and protected the lungs.
- Duamutef had the head of a jackal and carried and protected the stomach.



In our topic work, we have been investigating mechanisms and have designed and built a shaduf (an ancient Egyptian mechanism for taking water out of The Nile). The children used their knowledge of levers to build them.
