Home learning and daily Zoom catch up sessions

Dear Parents / Carers,

Firstly, thank you for your patience at this deeply unsettling and frustrating time for us all. You will have hopefully been able to access our home learning materials through the google drive by now but please let us know if you continue to struggle.

We want to go further with the home learning and we are pleased to tell you that from Monday, we will be expanding our home learning offer to include:

Twice daily pastoral Zoom sessions with a staff member. This will be a chance for the children to see each other and the teacher for a 'catch up' and to be able to respond to issues from the learning the day before. The second session will be a story with your year group. We know that communication and feeling like a class still is something you identified to us as a priority last time.

At least one recorded lesson a day, focusing on a core area of the curriculum (English, Maths, Science). This will look different for each year group. This will be to complement the already detailed learning plans available on the google drive.

Class Dojo (Y1,2,3,4,5,6) / Tapestry (F2 and Nursery) will become a way to communicate with the staff and to send work to them for feedback. You should be receiving an invite for this soon if you haven't had it already. Once you have registered and logged in, you can send documents, pictures etc to the staff. Staff will respond during office hours to these messages. It is also a good way to send non-urgent messages directly to the teacher. This will replace email, although the office and Mr Head will still use email in the normal way.

Facebook will still be used for sharing our Friday Gold book assembly and other information. Mr Head also plans to run some 'live' sessions similar to the ones we had during the last lockdown.

There will also be other year group-specific resources, such as Read, Write Inc and reading resources made available.
