Dear Parents/Carers,

As a school, we always strive to ensure that Children and Families are supported as well as they can be. It is for this reason that we are highlighting the free school meal provision available for some families meeting the criteria.

Although ALL children in KS1 receive universal free school meals, those who meet the criteria will also be eligible for additional funding (Pupil Premium Grant). This is money that can be used by the school to support your child's education and it used in school to pay for small group support and even to help towards the cost of Educational Visits.

If you are in receipt of any of the following you may be eligible for Free school meals and/or the Pupil Premium Grant:

Universal Credit (Annual Net income of no more than £7,400)

Income Support

Income based Jobseekers Allowance (JSA)

Income related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)

Support under part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

The Guarantee element of the State pension Credit

Working Tax Credit Run-on

Child Tax Credit (Not working tax credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190

To see if you are eligible

The process is simple and can be completed online. You will get an instant decision. The result is strictly confidential and only shared with the school if you are eligible. The school will treat this information with confidentiality.
