Covid Guidance update

Thank you for your ongoing support. You will undoubtedly have heard about the planned changes for schools as part of stage 4 of the government's roadmap. The date that is currently being worked to is Monday 19 July.

The main changes are:

- That 'bubbles' in schools will no longer be required after this date.
- The need for staggered start and end times could stop from this date.
- The requirement for close contacts to isolate will end on 16 August.
- The requirement to wear a face covering will become voluntary.

As a school, we have worked hard this academic year to keep everyone safe and minimise the numbers of children that have had to be sent home to self-isolate due to a positive covid case.

We want to ensure that as National restrictions change that we continue to keep all of our community safe.

We plan to keep the bubbles within school to stop any potential spread leading children and families to isolate during the summer break.

We will continue with the staggered start and end times as we do not wish to change routines that we have used all year, as these are established with the pupils.

We will still ask any adults entering our school premises to wear a mask (if they are able to).

From September, we will follow the advice available at that time and will notify parents in advance of the start of term. At this point in time, we would expect the staggered start and end times to end, to remove the use of 'bubbles' and, based on the current guidance, only positive cases will be required to isolate. Our priority will always be to aim to keep everyone as safe as possible all of the time.
