## **Collection for the Rosie May Foundation**

On Friday we will be launching a collection for the Rosie May Foundation.

## Who are The Rosie May Foundation?

A Nottingham charity, which helps children in Sri Lanka and Nepal. They help children to go to school and to learn so that they have a brighter future. During the pandemic, they have helped people in Bingham and surrounding villages by delivering hot meals, medicines and lockdown cupcakes. In Nepal, Rosie May Foundation rebuilt a Primary school that was destroyed in the 2015 earthquakes. Children are provided with uniforms, a hot meal and a hot shower whilst at school. In Sri Lanka, the Rosie May Pre-School provides school meals, uniforms and school bags. For many children they are the first in their family to have an early years education.

## How can you help?

The Rosie May foundation will give you each a tube of Smarties.

You take the tube home and eat the Smarties. If you don't like Smarties or can't eat them, give them to someone who does BUT keep the tube.

Fill the tube with as many 20p and £1.00 coins as you can. It does not matter if you do not completely fill it. Every little bit of money will help.
