This is as part of our Discover Curriculum (History-Based) and will mean that the children will be off their typical timetable for the day. Each year group will focus on a particular topic and will participate in a number of different activities throughout the day. These topics are as follows:

Year 2: Life as a soldier/Clothing

Year 3: Life at home during the war/Rationing

Year 4: Evacuees

Year 5: Animals in the war

Year 6: Propaganda/Life as a soldier

We have also planned for the children to take part in an online webinar which will allow children to access learning about the world wars in an interactive, memorable way.
