Dear Parents/Carers,

Uniform expectations for all pupils

It is important for children to come to school with the correct school uniform. This is essential in helping the pupils to feel proud of their school and to set themselves high expectations.

We expect all pupils to have correct uniform at all times while attending school. We understand that uniform can be as follows:

- Appropriate footwear (Black shoes)
- School jumper **OR** equivalent burgundy coloured jumper.
- School blue t-shirt **OR** equivalent pale blue t-shirt
- Grey trousers **OR** Grey Skirt **OR** Grey dress **OR** summer dress (pale blue gingham)
- School tie (Optional).

PE kit

- Appropriate footwear – Plimsolls or trainers that can be secured with Velcro/laces.
- School PE t-shirt **OR** plain pale blue t-shirt.
- Burgundy shorts
- Plain black joggers
- Black school PE hoody **OR** equivalent plain black hoody
- Earrings should be removed on PE days and long hair tied back for Health and Safety reasons.

Where pupils come to school with incorrect uniform/PE kit we will communicate this with parents using DOJO rather than the pupils.

If there are medical reasons why pupils cannot wear PE kits, this needs to be discussed with Mrs Wilkes the School SENDCO and we may require this in writing from a medical professional.

Although we are happy for pupils to wear equivalent uniform from supermarkets etc. there may be times when financial issues mean that families struggle to source or pay for uniform. If this is the case, please talk to us in the strictest confidence.

Please help us to ensure all the pupils have the correct uniform after half term.
